



FORMER NAVAL AIR WARFARE CENTER WARMINSTER PFAS DRINKING WATER PROGRAM

The United States Navy is conducting drinking water well sampling in a designated area near NAWC Warminster.

The Navy is conducting a private well investigation in a designated sampling area near former Naval Air Warfare Center (NAWC) Warminster. Based on our record review, we believe the drinking water consumed on your property or irrigation water used on your property, may come from a private well. If this is the case, we would like permission to sample your well water. The Navy is not seeking to sample water provided by a public (town) water supply.

This sampling will be at no cost to you. The chemicals the Navy is testing for are certain per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS), which may be present in these private water wells due to past uses of the firefighting agent called aqueous film-forming foam (AFFF) at former NAWC Warminster.

The Navy has contracted with Resolution Consultants to complete private drinking water well sampling for PFAS in the expanded areas below near former NAWC Warminster.
